From the Desk of Apostles Jeff & Dr. Linda Herbert:

Decree the Transference of Wealth

Recent revelation from the prophets reveals that during this time of plague, God not only wants to provide our need, but also wants to transfer wealth to us for an abundance. Ephesians 3:20 states, “Now to Him who is able to do exceedingly abundantly above all that we ask or think, according to the power that works in us” (NKJV). Despite the circumstances we are in today, we know that God is for us and we are highly favored by the Lord. The Lord promised us that in whatever circumstance we are in, He will not only provide our need, but also give us the abundance. Philippians 4:19 states, “And my God shall supply all your need according to His riches in glory by Christ Jesus.”

In order to understand the Lord’s intent for us during this time, we need knowledge of what He means by wealth and transference of wealth, and we need to know his strategy for obtaining it. According to the Merriam-Webster dictionary, wealth is, “abundance of valuable material possessions or resource.”^[1] From God’s perspective, he has made us spiritually wealthy because he has poured out his Spirit on all flesh (Acts 2:17). Wealth in monetary terms means an abundance, but what does abundance mean? Abundance is a relative term in that it is different for each person. Wealth means, “an ample quantity: an abundant amount.”^[2] Consequently, wealth and abundance are different for each person. Regardless of these definitions, however, the Bible says that God will provide our need and give us the abundance, so we can believe for great provision in our life.

Transference of wealth occurs when money is given to you from another source. For example, during this time of plague, the US government is providing money to stimulate the economy by giving money to individuals and state governments. The government stimulus

checks given to people, social security checks, retirement checks, unemployment checks, investment increases, salary increases, and even money that comes from friends, family, and alms giving, etc. are all examples of sources of transference of wealth! These are sources that God uses to bless his people with provision. Because we lack knowledge of how God provides, sometimes we can miss His blessing and provision in our life. But if we can humble ourselves before the Lord, we can receive the provision and the transference of wealth that the Lord provides from all of these sources!

The Lord wants to transfer wealth to us to not only meet our need, but to enable us to possess the land that God promised to us. Instead of operating in 'survival mode,' the Lord wants us to believe Him for great blessing. One of the earliest biblical examples of transference of wealth occurred during the Exodus of the Israelites where the Israelites received plunder from the Egyptians as they fled Egypt. In Genesis 1:28 the Bible states, "then God blessed them and said, "Be fruitful and multiply. Fill the earth and govern it" (NLT). God wants us to be fruitful. Fruitful means to. "bear fruit, grow, and increase."^[3] He also wants us to govern and possess the land. Consequently, we need to believe God to bear fruit, increase through transference of wealth to possess the land.

The Word of God teaches that God gives the power to get wealth. Jesus demonstrated this during His ministry on earth as He always walked in supernatural provision. Deuteronomy 8:18 says, "But you shall remember the Lord your God for it is He who is giving you power to make wealth, that He may confirm His covenant He swore to your fathers, as it is this day." Second Corinthians 9:8 states, "And God is able to provide you with every blessing in abundance and will generously provide all you need. Then you will always have everything you need and plenty left over to share with others" (NLT). We see the demonstration of these scriptures when Jesus fed the 5000 with five loaves of bread and two fish (Matt 14:13-21). In Matthew 17:27, the Lord supernaturally provided the tax money to Peter to pay the taxes! In John 21:6, Jesus told Peter to cast his net on the right side of the boat and he caught such a multitude of fish that they could not haul it in! Thus, throughout scripture, the power to get wealth and supernatural provision was demonstrated during Jesus three-year ministry, as well as the provision provided to the disciples as they went on their missionary journeys.

Today, God is calling us to extend our faith and decree the transference of wealth in our

lives – for His Glory. A decree is, “a formal and authoritative order having the force of law”^[4] A good example of a decree occurred when Queen Esther was told to write a decree for the saving of the Jewish people. Esther was told by her husband, the King, to write “another decree in the king's name in behalf of the Jews as seems best to you, and seal it with the king's signet ring--for no document written in the king's name and sealed with his ring can be revoked.”(Esther 8:8). “The king's edict granted the Jews in every city the right to assemble and protect themselves; to destroy, kill and annihilate the armed men of any nationality or province who might attack them and their women and children, and to plunder the property of their enemies” (Esther 8:11). The decree shifted an entire nation in all ways and resulted in the protection of the Jewish people. As we decree in Jesus Name, shifts will occur in our life resulting in the transference of wealth.

So, how so we decree transference of wealth?

First, we always use the Word of God as our basis because the Word of God is our authority in the Spirit. Second, we state what we want, according to the Word of God. Then, continue to decree until you see the manifestation, and praise God for the answer!

Here is an example decree:

We decree that all of our bills are paid, we have a good paying job that more than meets our expenses, and we do not have any lack, because the Word of God states according to Philippians 4:19, “And my God shall supply all your need according to His riches in glory by Christ Jesus.” Second Corinthians 9:8 states, “And God is able to provide you with every blessing in abundance and will generously provide all you need. Then you will always have everything you need and plenty left over to share with others” (NLT).

And he has given to me the power to get wealth in accordance with Deuteronomy 8:18 that says, “But you shall remember the Lord your God for it is He who is giving you power to make wealth, that He may confirm His covenant He swore to your fathers, as it is this day.” In accordance with these scriptures we decree no lack, all bills paid and we have the abundance, In Jesus Name.

Be encouraged in the Lord today. He is with you, He loves you, He is providing, and He is transferring wealth to you! Praise Him for it.

From the Desk of Elder

Is This Really You Lord?

Have you ever second guessed yourself when the Lord told you to pray for someone, deliver a prophetic word or do a prophetic act? Recently, the Lord told me to deliver a prophetic word to someone. In fact, the Lord told me 3 times! I was not disobedient. At the time, I questioned whether it was the Lord's will because the individual has a strong and combative personality. Finally, I stepped out on faith and delivered the word. I recorded the word and sent it to her email, to my surprise, she responded right away. She revealed to me that the word was confirmation from the Lord.

The experience reminded me of Acts 9:11-17 when the Lord told Ananias, to go to the house of Judas on Straight Street and ask for a man from Tarsus named Saul because he was praying. The Lord caused Saul to lose his sight. In a vision Saul saw a man named Ananias come and place his hands on him to restore his sight. But Ananias answered the

Lord and said “I have heard many reports about this man and all the harm he has done to your holy people in Jerusalem. And he has come here with authority from the chief priests to arrest all who call on your name.” But the Lord told Ananias to go because Saul was His chosen instrument to proclaim His name to the Gentiles, their kings and to the people of Israel.

Out of obedience, Ananias went to the house and entered it. Placing his hands on Saul, he said, “Brother Saul, the Lord—Jesus, who appeared to you on the road as you were coming here—has sent me so that you may see again and be filled with the Holy Spirit.” Immediately, something like scales fell from Saul’s eyes, and he could see again. He got up and was baptized, and after taking some food, he regained his strength.

Can you imagine being Ananias and having to pray for someone who was on a mission to cause you harm? The key message here is that we must trust the Lord and know that He is with us. Proverb 3: 5 says that we are to trust the Lord with all our heart and lean not unto our own understanding.

We are the Lord’s chosen vessels to do amazing acts in this world. Trust him and step out on faith even when it sounds difficult.
